<p>Typed/Written Research</p> <p>Research one topic to create a profile on. Type this out and include pictures from the internet or write it out and make drawings and sketches by hand.</p>	<p>Powerpoint</p> <p>Create a PowerPoint presentation on a topic of your choice. Write down information in your own words. Include pictures and even animations.</p>	<p>Poster</p> <p>Create a colourful poster advertising a topic from ancient Rome. What sorts of words would you use? What colours and fonts would you choose?</p>
<p>Create a model or costume</p> <p>Use paper, cardboard, modeling clay, play-doh, plastic, or any material to create a model on your topic. Label it with some description to show how much you have learnt.</p>	<p>Movie Making</p> <p>Create a video of yourself explaining one topic of your choice. Can you vary your tone and expressions to engage and teach your audience?</p>	<p>A painting or collage</p> <p>Paint or create a collage on a topic you are interested in. How might you add details on your topic that show how much you know? Make sure to sign your name at the bottom of your art.</p>
