

BDIS Secondary School Parent and Student Information- Returning To School August 2021







Getting Ready For School

Please Bring to School:

- A face mask and a spare in a sealed container (both face masks should be labelled with your name, preferably on the outside).
- Face masks are required to be worn at all times (exception when eating)
- Snacks (as no snacks will be sold in school initially)
- Refillable water bottle (preferably 2 litres)
- Packed lunch (if not eating school lunches)
- Small bottle of hand sanitiser to be kept on your person (optional)

When students are getting ready for school, make sure that they do not have any of the following symptoms: a fever, dry cough, tiredness, aches and pains, nasal congestion, runny nose of sore throat. If they do, Students should not come to school.







Protocols on School Buses

- On collection pupils will have their temperatures taken and be asked to sanitise their hands.
- They will not be allowed to board if their temperatures are above 37.5°
- Pupils will sit in seats on the window side.
- Windows are allowed to be opened when safe. Therefore a maximum number stipulated for each size of bus.
- Regular disinfectant cleaning after each journey.







Arrival At School

All students will sanitise as they enter the school site. They will go directly to their form rooms at 7.15am. All students will have their temperatures taken at their form rooms by their form teacher.

If students are late to school, students report to reception where they will be registered sanitised and temperature checked.

Students will not be admitted to school after 8.30am without SLT clearance.

All students will be briefed fully on the first day of return to school regarding all COVID protocols now in place.







LESSONS

All classrooms will be cleaned to the required standards twice per day.

All classrooms will have a 1.5m centre to centre seating plan to allow for adequate social distancing. Each class will have a student seating plan for each lesson creating a more consistent entry and exit to the classroom.

Students will sanitise between each lesson and will be instructed to wipe down their desks when leaving the classroom. Students will also have the opportunity to clean their desks if they wish prior to the start of each lesson.

During lessons, students will not be permitted to move around the class unless guided by the teacher or share equipment.

Students will be allowed access to their lockers at registration, break and lunchtime.







Teaching And Learning- Face To Face

All teachers to have clear seating plans for their students. The seating plans will be maintained throughout the term.

Teachers to share resources via google classroom

As much marking as possible to be done via google classroom

Students to be allowed into classes with social distancing







Sharing Of Equipment

Students may not share any equipment to include

- Calculators
- Sports equipment
- Science equipment
- Art material

Specialist subject have individual cleaning duties assigned to these areas.







Movement From Lesson to Lesson.

Students will be able to sanitise between lessons at various locations throughout the school with auto sanitisers. Sanitisers will also be placed in each classroom.

Students are also encouraged to carry their own sanitiser.

Students will be dismissed in 3s and 4s and will be encouraged to move efficiently to their next lesson.

Students will be instructed to keep to the left on the stairs and on each level.







Physical Education Lessons

All students will come to school dressed in PE Kit if they have a scheduled lesson.

The changing rooms will not be used.

Lessons will be conducted with COVID protocols.

Bags to be kept in set secure locations







TOILETS

There will be a maximum number of 6 students permitted in any student toilet.

Adequate soap will be provided in all toilets and adequate bins will be provided for waste paper.







Use of Lockers and Pegs

Students will only be allowed access to their lockers during registration, break and lunchtime.







Breaks and Lunches

Social distance measures will be maintained and students will be able to sit safely in zoned areas.

School lunches will be eaten in the dining hall and packed lunches in year specific areas of the garden.







Rainy Days

Students will use the lunch hall and covered corridors.







Teachers will communicate specifically regarding their club.

Clubs may run at lunchtime

After school clubs will begin at 3.00pm and end at 4.00pm.

Late bus will leave at 4pm.







Sickbay/Sickness and Isolation Rooms

Sick students report as usual to the sickbay

Parents will be contacted to collect their son/daughter as a matter of urgency

Students that present COVID type symptoms will be isolated in separate isolation rooms.

Parents will be contacted to collect their son/daughter as a matter of urgency.

The school nurse will support all students requiring attention.









End Of The School Day

The end of the day will be as of last year.

However students are encouraged to maintain social distance and are asked to keep their facemask on.
